Children's Code of Conduct

At **Live Laugh Learn 4 Life**, we want every child to have a **fun, safe, and positive experience** at our Easter Camp. To ensure this, we ask all children to follow this **Code of Conduct**:

1. Be Respectful

- Treat fellow campers, staff, and volunteers with **kindness and respect**.
- Listen when others are speaking and follow instructions from staff.
- Respect the space, equipment, and belongings of others.

2. Be Safe

- Follow all safety rules and stay within designated camp areas.
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself—**no pushing, hitting, or rough play**.
- Inform a staff member if you feel unsafe or see something concerning.

3. Be a Team Player

- Encourage others and **work together as a team**.
- Include everyone in activities—**no bullying, teasing, or excluding others**.
- Respect different opinions and abilities.

4. Try Your Best

- Participate with a **positive attitude and enthusiasm**.
- Challenge yourself and **try new activities**.
- If something is difficult, ask for help rather than giving up.

5. Keep It Clean

- Take care of your environment—clean up after yourself.
- Use equipment properly and return it when finished.

6. Follow Camp Rules

- Arrive **on time** and be ready for activities.
- Stay with your group and always ask permission before leaving an area.
- Use kind words—**no swearing, name-calling, or rude language**.

Consequences for Not Following the Code of Conduct

We want every child to enjoy camp, but if rules are not followed:

1. **First Reminder:** A gentle reminder from staff.
2. **Second Reminder:** A short time-out from the activity.
3. **Final Warning:** A conversation with a staff member and possible communication with parents.
4. **Serious Incidents:** If behaviour is unsafe or repeatedly disruptive, parents may be asked to collect their child, and continued participation in the camp may be reviewed.
